The Association currently has about £5000 more than it did this time last year. WASACRE has moved from an over spend to an under spend, due to not having a conference this year, and there has been less translation during 2014/15. Another big outgoing that WASACRE no longer has to pay is the subscription to RE News. John Mitson confirmed that all SACREs have paid their annual subscription to WASACRE this year and in the current financial climate that is a tribute to the way local authorities view this organisation. John also noted that Bank interest has gone down by seven pence.</p>

Cyfeiriwyd hefyd at y Datganiad o Gyfrifon a nodwyd fod llogi ystafelloedd yn un peth sy'n amrywio ynghyd â chyfieithu dogfennau, bob blwyddyn. Hefyd, bu cynnydd yn y tanysgrifiad i'r Cyngor Addysg Grefyddol eleni. Tynnodd John Mitson sylw at y swm anarferol a dalwyd i EFTRE eleni fel tanysgrifiad blynyddol. Roedd hyn oherwydd i'r anfoneb gael ei derbyn mewn Euros a'r anawsterau i'w thalu o'r pen hwn, a olygodd daliadau cyfnewid ychwanegol. Sicrhaodd John Mitson yr aelodau fod gan CCYSAGauC fantolen iach, sy'n gosod y Gymdeithas mewn lle da ar gyfer y flwyddyn sy'n dod. Bydd gan CCYSAGauC y cyfle i wneud y gweithgareddau y mae angen eu gwneud er mwyn hyrwyddo addysg grefyddol yng Nghymru a chodi proffil y Gymdeithas. Bydd Libby Jones yn trefnu i'r dogfen gael ei chyfieithu ac yn anfon copi wyieithog i'r CYSAGau.

Derbyniwyd yr adroddiad gan yr aelodau, cynigiwyd gan Rheinallt Thomas ac eiliwyd gan Phil Lord. Diolchodd Gavin Creigen i'r Trysorydd, John Mitson, am ei waith gwerthfawr a'i gefnogaeth barhaus i'r Gymdeithas.

Argymhellodd John Mitson i'r aelodau y dylid codi'r tanysgrifiad blynyddol i CCYSAGauC i adlewyrchu'r chwyddiant presennol. Ei gyngor oedd codi'r swm i £433.00 i bob awdurdod lleol, sef cynnydd o 2.5%. Derbyniodd yr aelodau gyngor y Trysorydd a hefyd ei argymhelliad fod costau teithio i gyfarfodydd yn dal i gael eu talu i'r aelodau.

5. Sylwadau'r Cadeirydd Ymadawol / *Outgoing Chair's comments*

Yn absenoldeb Tania ap Sion, darllenodd Libby Jones sylwadau'r Cadeirydd Ymadawol ar ei rhan. Mae'r rhain wedi'u cynnwys ar ddiwedd y cofnodion.

Diolchodd Gavin i Tania am ei harweiniad a dywedodd ei bod, drwy ei chadernid bonheddig a'i phenderfyniad, wedi cyflawni llawer o bethau i'r

The Statement of Accounts was also referred to and room hire was noted as a variable along with the translation of documents each year. Also, there has been an increase in the RE Council subscription this year. John Mitson commented that on the unusual figure paid to EFTRE this year for its annual subscription. This was due to the invoice being received in Euros and difficulties paying it from this end, which resulted in extra charges for exchange. John Mitson assured members that WASACRE has a healthy balance sheet putting the Association in a good position for the year ahead. WASACRE will have the opportunity to do the activities it needs to do in order to promote religious education in Wales and to raise the profile of WASACRE. Libby Jones will arrange for the translation of the document and circulate a bilingual copy to SACREs.

The report was accepted by members, proposed by Rheinallt Thomas and seconded by Phil Lord. Gavin Craigen thanked Treasurer, John Mitson for his valuable work and ongoing support for the Association.

John Mitson recommended to members that the annual subscription to WASACRE should be increased to reflect current inflation. His advice was to raise the amount to £433.00 per local authority, which is a 2.5% increase. Members accepted the Treasurer's advice and also accepted his recommendation that travel expenses should continue to be paid to members for meetings.
